ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed for the issuance of Writ of Mandamus, directing the first respondent to issue a No Objection Certificate to the petitioner to run a SPA i.e. cross relaxation massage in the name and style of "ROYAL WELLNESS CARE AND SPA" at No.3, Saravana Complex, 3rd Floor Phase – 1, Opp. Raja Rani Residency, Tirupathur, Tirupathur District Pin-635 601, by passing orders on the petitioner's representation dated 01.06.2023.

2.It is the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is running a SPA i.e. cross relaxation massage in the name and style of "ROYAL WELLNESS CARE AND SPA" at No.3, Saravana Complex, 3rd Floor Phase – 1, Opp. Raja Rani Residency, Tirupathur, Tirupathur District Pin-635 601. He would further submit that the petitioner has made a representation dated 01.06.2023 to the respondents seeking for the issuance of "No Objection Certificate" to run the said business and the same is not considered by the
