**TERMS OF SETTLEMENT**

This Civil Miscellaneous Appeal had been filed by the Appellants/Claimants as against award of a sum of Rs.14,80,000/- (Rupees



Fourteen Lakhs and Eighty Thousand Only) by the Tribunal. The second Respondent/Insurance Company entered into an agreement with the Appellants/Claimants whereby, the Appellants/Claimants agreed to receive a sum of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five laksh only), in full quit, over and above the award already passed by the Tribunal.

2.It was agreed that the Appellants/Claimants are entitled to full enhanced sum of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five lakhs only) in full quit, over and above the award already passed by the Tribunal.

3.The second Respondent/Insurance Company is directed to deposit the agreed amount within a period of 8 weeks from today.

4.On such deposit, the Appellants/Claimants are entitled to withdraw the entire amount as apportioned by Tribunal. The withdrawal regarding the award of the minors shall be as ordered by the Tribunal. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition, if any, is closed.
