ORDER

The petitioner seeks an accommodation under Affordable Housing in Partnership (AHP) scheme based on the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY) at North Giriappa Road, T.Nagar, Chennai 600 017 and has made an application to the 2nd respondent. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the 3rd respondent has already made a recommendation to the 2nd respondent and the papers are pending with him.

2.Mr.G.Venkatesan, the learned counsel has taken notice for the respondents.

3.The respondents are now required to consider the case of the petitioner for an allotment of a house under Affordable Housing in Partnership (AHP) scheme
