ORDER

The petitioners' complain that their bank accounts were frozen and for long, they were kept in dark about it. They later realized that at the instance of DB Marg Police Station, Mumbai they were frozen.

2.The learned counsel for the petitioners also submitted that the Reserve Bank of India, the first respondent has responded to his complaint and suggested to him to approach the Banking Ombudsman for redressal.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions also submitted that his clients would be approaching the Banking Ombudsman.

5.The Writ Petition is accordingly closed. No costs.
