This Petition has been filed seeking to condone the delay of 344 days in filing the above Civil Miscellaneous Appeal.

2. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners/appellants would submit that the first respondent remained ex-parte before the Tribunal and he has made an endorsement to dispense with notice to the first respondent.

3. Mr.J.Chandran, learned counsel, takes notice for the second respondent and undertakes to file vakalat and stated no objection, providing the appellants' forfeit the interest rate.
