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COMMON ORDER

We have heard Mr.A.Kalaivanan, learned counsel for the petitioners and Mr.P.Kumaresan, learned Additional Advocate-General, assisted by Mrs.R.Anitha, learned Special Government Pleader for respondents 1 to 3, 5 and 6; and, Mr.R.Bharanidharan, learned counsel for respondent No.4.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Additional Advocate-General for the respondent State submit that the government order challenged in the present writ petitions, bearing G.O.(Ms) No.65, Human Resources Management (B) Department, dated 4.7.2022, is withdrawn under G.O.(Ms) No.74, Human Resources Management (B) Department, dated 16.8.2023.

3. As in the present writ petitions the challenge is only to G.O.(Ms) No.65, Human Resources Management (B) Department, dated 4.7.2022 and the same stands withdrawn, nothing would survive in these writ petitions.
