2.By consent of parties, this Court appoints

a)Mr.Sanjay Pinto, Advocate, having Office address at No.5, 'Manasarovar', 1st Floor, 60, C.P.Ramaswamy Road, Alwarpet, Chennai-600 018, Mobile No.98400 91547 as the Sole Arbitrator to adjudicate the



dispute between the applicants and the respondent arising out of the agreement dated 28.06.2022;

b) The Sole Arbitrator shall be paid his remuneration / fees in accordance with the 4th schedule of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996;

c) Both the parties shall share equally the fees payable to the Sole Arbitrator;

d) The Sole Arbitrator shall adhere to the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 while passing the arbitral award;

e) The Sole Arbitrator shall complete the arbitration within the stipulated time as prescribed under the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.

3. Accordingly, this application is disposed of and the applicants are granted liberty to file a similar application before the Arbitrator under
