In the light of the above, there shall be a direction to the petitioner to give a fresh complaint to the 2nd respondent along with all the relevant documents and the same shall be considered by the 2nd respondent in line with the Circular issued by the Director General of Police, Tamil Nadu dated 01.04.2022 and a final decision shall be taken, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of the complaint from the petitioner.

6. This writ petition is disposed of in the above terms. No Costs.
