Prayer in W.P.No.19946 of 2020: The writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to permit the petitioner to exercise option based on the results to be published for Round-2 counseling on 23.12.2020 to get upgradation by participating in the process of filling up the stray vacancies arising due to unfilled/exited seats by Round-1 and Round-2 candidates, in the form of "Stray Vacancy Round Counseling", by framing the criteria to fill up the stray vacancy in accordance with merit in selection based on marks secured in NEET-SS 2020, as per Medical Council of India Regulations, based on the representation submitted by the petitioner through Email dated 14.12.2020.

Prayer in W.P.No.19953 of 2020: The writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to allow the petitioner to participate in the Stray Vacancy Counseling to be conducted for unfilled/exited seats after Round-1 and Round-2 counseling in respect of Super Specialty Course in DNB Surgical Oncology 2020-2021 in accordance with merit in selection based on the marks secured in NEET-SS 2020, based on the representation submitted by the petitioner through Email dated 14.12.2020.
