ORDER

This Criminal Miscellaneous petition is filed seeking suspension of sentence imposed by the learned Sessions Judge, Magalir Neethimandram, Fast Track Mahila Court, Tiruppur in Spl.S.C.No.53 of 2022 on 22.06.2023 and to enlarge the petitioner on bail.



2. The petitioner is an accused in Spl.S.C.No.53 of 2022 before the learned Sessions Judge, Magalir Neethimandram, Fast Track Mahila Court, Tiruppur and he was convicted and sentenced on 22.06.2023 as follows:

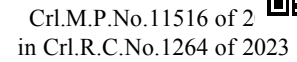
<i>S.No.</i>	<i>Provision under which convicted</i>	<i>Sentence</i>
1	Section 7 r/w. 8 of POCSO Act, 2012	Rigorous imprisonment for a period of three years and to pay a fine of Rs.1,000/-, in default, to undergo Rigorous imprisonment for three months.

3. Heard Mr.R.Radha Pandian, the learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.S.Sugendran, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner contended that there are arguable points in the Criminal Revision and hence, he prayed for suspension of sentence.

5. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor did not raise any serious objection for granting suspension of sentence to the revision petitioner.

6. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel appearing on either side, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the sentence
