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3.When the matter was taken up for hearing today, Mr.M.Sebastian, Special Sub-Inspector, Anthiyur Police Station, Erode District was present and he stated that he along with the Inspector of Police went to the spot and physically verified and found that there was no club running in that place and there was no building structure.

4.In view of the specific stand taken by the respondent police, their interference in running of the recreation club will not arise.

5.This writ petition is disposed of by recording the specific stand taken by the respondent police. No Costs.
