This Petition has been filed seeking to condone the delay of 414 days in filing the above captioned C.M.A.

2.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the 1st respondent remained *ex-parte* before the Tribunal and therefore, he requested to dispense with notice to the 1st respondent and had also made an endorsement to that effect. Hence, notice to the 1st respondent is dispensed with.

3.Though notice served on the 2nd respondent, none entered appearance on behalf of them.

4.Considering the averments made in the affidavit filed in support of this petition and being satisfied with the same, the delay is condoned on the condition that the petitioner shall forfeit the interest for the delay period in the event this Court enhancing the compensation. Hence, this petition is ordered as prayed for.

5.Registry is directed to number the C.M.A., if it is otherwise in order and list the same in due course.
