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ORDER

5.The petitioner is directed to work out his remedy after perusing the said report.



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6.Learned Government Advocate also informed the Court that the Tahsildar, Egmore is a jurisdictional Tahsildar for the purpose.

7.This writ petition stands disposed of accordingly. No costs. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
