Learned counsel appearing for the respondent submits that in the operative portion of the order, a direction was given to V Additional Family Court, Chennai to dispose the M.C.No.69 of 2022 within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order instead of I Additional Family Court, Chennai. Further, the learned counsel appearing for the respondent submits that as directed by the Lower Court, the petitioner has not paid the interim maintenacnce to the respondent.

3. Considering the submissions made, the operative portion of the order i.e., paragraph No.5 shall be read as:

“Considering the fact of the case, the I Additional Family Court, Chennai, is directed to dispose of the M.C.No.69 of 2022 within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

As directed by the Lower Court, the petitioner shall pay the interim maintenance to the respondent within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.”
