Considering the fact that the bar attached to the Recreation Club of the petitioner has remained closed in view of the impugned suspension order dated 20.05.2023 and considering the fact that the reasons given *prima facie* appears to be non-sustainable, the impugned order bearing R.C.No.P&E2(1)/2563/2023 of the first respondent dated 20.05.2023 suspending the bar license shall be kept in abeyance pending disposal of the



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show cause proceedings by the first respondent within the aforesaid period.

No costs. Consequently, connected Writ Miscellaneous Petitions are closed.
