Heard Mr.V.Balamurugan, learned counsel appearing for the applicant, Mr.P.Muthukumar, learned State Government Pleader appearing for respondents 1 and 2 in C.M.P.No.18705 of 2023 and for respondents 1 to 3 in C.M.P.No.18726 of 2023 and Mr.C.Venkateshkumar, learned counsel appearing for respondent 3 in C.M.P.No.18705 of 2023.

These petitions are filed to condone the delay of 138 days in representing the appeals.

Mr.C.Venkateshkumar, learned counsel appearing for respondent 3 in C.M.P.No.18705 of 2023 opposes the petitions on the ground that no sufficient cause is mentioned.
