5.This Court now directs the petitioner to make a fresh application to the second respondent, and the second respondent is required to comply with the internal procedural formalities and dispose of the petitioner's application within a period of twelve (12) weeks from the date on which the petitioner makes his representation / application for renewal of his gun license.

6.This Writ Petition stands disposed of accordingly. No Costs.
