After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties, they arrived at a compromise to settle the matter as follows:

TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

2. The appellant insurance company had already deposited Rs.3,25,707/- inclusive of interest and cost as awarded by the Tribunal. Now on appeal, they themselves settled for **Rs.2,00,032/-** as full quit. Hence the balance amount of **Rs.1,25,675/- (Rupees One lakh Twenty-Five Thousand and Six Hundred and Seventy-Five only)** from the above deposited amount has to be refunded to the appellant / insurance company.

3. Accordingly, this Civil miscellaneous appeal is closed. Consequently the connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
