**TERMS OF SETTLEMENT**

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The Tribunal has awarded a sum of Rs.22,08,100/- along with interest at the rate of 7.5% per annum. Aggrieved by the said award amount, the Appellant/Claimants preferred this Appeal for enhancement.

2. After passing the award, The Insurance Company had deposited the entire amount before the Tribunal.

3. During the pendency of the Appeal, the Insurance Company arrived at a settlement, thereby, the Claimants/Respondents have agreed to receive enhanced sum of Rs.2,50,000/- in full quit over and above awarded by the Tribunal.

4. It was agreed that the appellant is entitled to full enhanced sum of Rs.2,50,000/- in addition to Rs.22,08,100/-, exclusively.

5. The second respondent/Insurance Company is directed to deposit the enhanced sum within a period of eight weeks from today (11.02.2023).

6. The first Appellant is entitled to withdraw the entire enhanced amount of Rs.2,50,000/-. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition, if any, is closed.
