This petition is filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C, to grant leave to file an appeal against the judgment dated 01.07.2023 made in STC.No.55/2021 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate No.I, Mettur, Salem District.

2. Heard Mr.C. Deepakkumar learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner/appellant contended that though the accused admitted his signature on the cheque, the trial court acquitted the accused on the ground that the complainant was running a Chit Fund and he had not proved the legally enforceable liability as against the accused. According to him, there are arguable points in the present appeal and prayed for allowing this petition.



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4. In the circumstances, leave is granted as prayed for.
