Prayer : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking for issuance of a Writ of Certiorari, Calling for the records pertaining to G.O.(Ms.) No. 3, Labour and Employment (12) Department dated 04.01.2019 issued by the 1st Respondent as well as G.O.(2D).No.7, Municipal Administration of Water Supply (MCI) Department, dated 24.01.2019 issued by the 2nd Respondent and quash Clause 17 (B) (2) and (3) of Tamil Nadu Manual Workers (Construction Workers) Welfare Scheme 1994 introduced through G.O.(Ms.)No.3, Labour and Employment (12) Department dated 04.01.2019 and consequential G.O.(2D).No.7, Municipal Administration of Water Supply (MCI) Department, dated 24.01.2019 to the extent it relates to reimbursement clause in Paragraph 7, namely “and to get reimbursement from Tamil Nadu construction workers Welfare Board on actual cost of production” as the same are contrary to the welfare of the registered construction workers and their welfare fund of the registered construction workers, pending disposal of the Writ Petition.
