ORDER

Heard Mr.R.Jayaprakash, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.P.Muthukumar, learned State Government Pleader assisted by Mrs.R.Anitha, learned Special Government Pleader for respondents 1 to 4.

2. The averments made in the present petition are absolutely vague and not supported by any specific instances. The names of the persons, who are the beneficiaries to the plots allotted and from whom the fifth respondent has allegedly taken amount, are not detailed.



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3. Such a petition, based on bald allegations and averments, cannot be entertained. If the petitioner has authentic information, supported with some *prima facie* proof of it, then may allege by filing a fresh petition. At present, this writ petition cannot be entertained.

4. In view of that, the writ petition stands disposed of. There will be no order as to costs.
