COMMON ORDER

These writ petitions have been filed seeking a direction to pay the difference of gratuity, commutation and pension arrears with interest at the rate of 18 % per annum within the stipulated time.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submitted that the difference amount as per eligibility would be paid within a period of eight weeks.

3. Recording the said submission, there shall be a direction to the respondent to pay eligible additional amount with interest at the rate of 4% per annum to the petitioners, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
