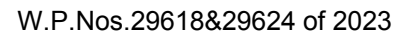

COMMON ORDER

The Writ Petitions are filed Seeking for an issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to pay interest @ 10% for the belated payment of terminal benefits such as gratuity provident fund, leave salary and commutation amount to the petitioners, the petitioners have come up with the present Writ Petitions.

2. With consent on either side, the main Writ Petitions itself are taken up for final disposal at the admission stage.

3. The brief facts of the case is that the petitioners joined the services of the respondents as Conductors and they have rendered nearly 25-33 years



4. The learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that the Division Bench of this Court in W.A.No.665 of 2018 dated 20.02.2018 has ordered to pay interest for the belated payment, therefore, representation was sent to the authorities, however, the same has not been considered, thereby seeks a direction to the respondents to consider the

Taking into consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and without going into the merits of the matter, there shall be a direction to the respondents to consider the representation made by the petitioners and to pay interest at the rate of 4% for the belated payment and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, if there is no legal impediment.

In view of the above, the present Writ Petitions are disposed of. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
