ORDER

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody
on 23.08.2023, registered by the respondent Police for the offence under
Section 302 of IPC in Crime No.1406 of 2023, seeks bail.

2.It is stated that there was a quarrel between A3 and the deceased and this was informed to A1 and A2 and subsequently, the deceased was taken away by A1 and given alcohol. A2 and A3 had held the deceased and A1 had assaulted the deceased leading to death.

3.A1 had been granted bail by the learned Principal Sessions Judge, Tiruppur on 05.10.2023.

4.Taking into consideration that particular fact and the period of incarceration, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

5. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on condition to execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Tiruppur and on further conditions that:

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent Police daily twice at 10.30 a.m and 5.30 p.m., until further orders;

[c] the petitioner shall not abscond either during

investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
