The petition has been taken out in C.M.P.No.20345 of 2022 for receiving additional documents, namely, 1. Valuation Report by approved valuer, 2. Lease Agreement dated 23.02.2021, 3. Coastal Regulation Clearance Document, 4. Clearance Certificate of Airport Authority of India.

2. The 3rd document which is the Coastal Regulation Clearance document is incomplete as it is only the 1st page which has been filed into Court. The learned counsel for the appellant assured the Court that the complete document will be filed into Court by 02.11.2023.
