The petitioners who were arrested and remanded to judicial custody for the offences under Sections 147, 148, 341, 324, 506(ii), 307 and 302 of IPC in Crime No.169 of 2023 on the file of the respondent Police, seek bail.

2.The petitioners are arrayed as A2, A3 and A12.

3.It is stated that the petitioners herein and the other accused had an affinity with the deceased and on the faithful day i.e., on 18.08.2023, they had a case at the Metropolitan Magistrate Court, Egmore. Thereafter, they had all gone over to Pattinapakkam/Foreshare Estate and had apparently come under the influence of liquor and all the other accused had also joined and the deceased was murdered and one person also suffered injuries, necessitating the registration of the crime also under Section 307 of IPC.

4.The learned counsel for the petitioner stated that A2 and A3 have been wrongly implicated in this case and A13 has no role at all in the entire offence.

5.However, it is also seen that as against the other accused, the process under Act 14 of 1982 had been initiated and they have been detained.

6.It is stated by the respondent that there are 6 previous cases against the first petitioner, out of which, three cases have been registered under Section 302 of IPC and there are 2 previous cases against the



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second petitioner registered under Section 302 of IPC. As far as the third petitioner is concerned, there is one previous case registered under 307 of IPC.

7.At this stage, restraint is required and this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

8. Hence this Criminal Original Petition stands dismissed.
