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ORDER

The petitioner seeks bail in Crime No.339 of 2023, registered by the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 8(c), 20(b)(ii)(B) of NDPS Act. He had been taken into custody on 14.09.2023.

2. It is stated that the petitioner was found in possession of 1.300 Kgs of ganja.

3. It is stated on the side of the respondent that there are four previous cases pending as against the petitioner in which, one is similar in nature.

4. Taking into consideration the period of incarceration undergone by the petitioner herein and that the contraband seized was an intermediate quantity, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner herein subject to the following conditions:

5. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on condition to execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the V Metropolitan Magistrate Court, Egmore, Chennai, and on further



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conditions that:

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioner shall report before respondent police everyday at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.

[c] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
