When the matter was taken up for hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the first respondent has filed an Interlocutory application No.6 of 2018 in O.A.Sr.No.35 of 2018 to condone the delay of 707 days in filing the said original application and the same was allowed on 05.12.2018 with a payment of costs of Rs.700/-, against which, the petitioner has filed the present Civil Revision Petition.
