This case came up for settlement before the National Lok Adalat. Both the parties are present. The learned counsel for the appellant for Mr.Anton Dhanasekaran and Mr.T.Suresh learned counsel for the respondents are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties, they arrived at a compromise to settle the matter as follows:

TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

This appeal has been filed by the Transport Corporation challenging the award dated 03.06.2022, for a sum of Rs.1,96,600/- (Rupees One Lakh



Ninety Six thousand and Six hundred only) with interest at 7.5% from the date of petition till the date of deposit of compensation and costs.

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2. The respondent/claimant and the learned counsel representing the appellant/Transport Corporation are present before the Lok Adalat. The Tribunal has awarded a sum of Rs.1,96,600/- (Rupees One Lakh Ninety Six thousand and Six hundred only) together with interest at the rate of 7.5% p.a. from the date of petition till the date of deposit of compensation. Pursuant to the Award, the appellant has deposited a sum of Rs.1,30,847/- representing 50% of the Award amount along with interest. Parties have agreed to settle the entire dispute on further payment of Rs.70,000/- (Rupees Seventy thousand only) in full quit.

3. Accordingly, the sum of Rs.70,000/- (Rupees Seventy thousand only) shall be deposited before the IV Court of Small Causes, Chennai, to the credit of MCOP No.791 of 2020, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Considering the age of the claimant, on such application, the Tribunal is directed to disburse the amount to the claimant immediately, without insisting for any formal application.
