This Petition has been filed to condone the delay of 57 days in filing the above Civil Miscellaneous Appeal.

2.Though notice was served to the first respondent, none appears before this Court.

3.Mr.S.ArunKumar, the learned counsel appears for the second respondent.

4.The learned counsel for the second respondent submits that he has no serious objection for the delay being condoned, subject to the condition that the petitioner forfeits the interest for the delay period of 57 days.

5.In view of the submission, the delay of 57 days is condoned subject to the condition that the petitioner shall not be entitled to interest for the delay period of 57 days.
