This matter is posted today before this Court under the caption “For Being Mentioned” at the instance of the learned counsel for the petitioner in respect of the order passed on 19.09.2023.

2. This Court by the order dated 19.09.2023 extended the time granted to the petitioner to comply with the order passed in the main Writ Petition. In the petition seeking extension of time, the petitioner has wrongly described the first respondent as the Regional Transport Authority, Tiruvannamalai, instead of the Regional Transport Authority, Villupuram. However, in the original Writ Petition, the first respondent was properly described as the Regional Transport Authority, Villupuram. The instant application has been filed to amend the cause title in W.M.P.No.26312 of 2023 to give correct description of the first respondent as the Regional Transport Authority, Villupuram, instead of the Regional Transport Authority, Tiruvannamalai.
