The matter is listed today under the caption “for being mentioned”.

2. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner stated that a mistake has crept into the paragraph Nos.2 & 4 of the order passed by this Court vide order dated 16.11.2023. Accordingly, he prays for appropriate orders.

3. In view of the above statement so made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the paragraph Nos.2 & 4 of the order dated 16.11.2023 is to be read as follows:

“2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner is alleged to have transported 6 units of savadu sand in a lorry. Hence, the complaint.

4.The learned Government Advocate(Crl. side) for the respondent stated that the petitioner had illegally transported 6 units of savadu sand without any permit. He also stated that there is no previous case against the petitioner. Hence, he vehemently opposed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.”
