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The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 323, 294(b) and 506(ii) of I.P.C, in Crime No. Not known of 2023, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.Today, when the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent Police submitted that petition enquiry is pending against the petitioner.
