



Crl.OP.No.26552 of 2023

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest for the alleged offences under Sections 341, 294(b), 353 and 506(ii) of IPC in Crime No.326 of 2023 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.It is the case of the prosecution that there were three accused. The petitioner is arrayed as A1. All the accused under the influence of alcohol created public nuisance.

3.Taking all the factors into consideration, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

4. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date on which the order copy made ready, before the learned District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate, Kattumannarkoil, on condition that the petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent police or the police officer who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed and on further condition that:

[a] the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.
