PRAYER: Criminal Original Petition is filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. praying to enlarge the Petitioner on bail in S.C.No.32 of 2021 on the file of the I Additional District Judge and Sessions Judge (FAC) Sessions Court for trial of Bomb Blast Cases, Coimbatore.

ORDER

The petitioner/A5 seeks bail in S.C.No.32 of 2021 now pending on the file of the learned I Additional District and Sessions Judge, Fast Track Court, Sessions Court for trial of Bomb Blast Cases, Coimbatore.

2.Since the petitioner had taken a decision not to appear before the



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Court, Non Bailable Warrant had been issued against him on 9.11.2023 and it was executed only on 23.07.2023.

3.The earlier application for bail had been dismissed by this Court on 09.11.2023 in Crl.O.P.No.24794 of 2023 on the ground that Non Bailable Warrant was pending against A6 and A7.

4.It now stated that A6 and A7 have been secured and PT warrant has been issued.

5.This is a change in circumstances of the case and also considering the period of incarceration, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

6.Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on condition to execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned I Additional District and Sessions Judge, Fast Track Court, Sessions Court for trial of Bomb Blast Cases, Coimbatore and on further conditions that:

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or



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Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioner shall report before the trial Court, everyday Monday, Wednesday and Friday and apart from the Court hearing dates, till completion of the trial.

[c] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
