This petition has been filed to condone the delay of 190 days in filing the above appeal.

2. The first respondent is set *ex parte vide* batta SR.No.8015.

3. Mr.R.V.Sivaraj, learned counsel, who takes notice for the second respondent, fairly submits that he has no serious objection to the delay of 190 days being condoned subject to the condition that the petitioner forfeits interest for the delay period of 190 days.

4. In view of the above submission made by the learned counsel for the second respondent, the delay of 190 days is condoned on condition that the petitioner forfeits interest for the delay period.
