ORDER

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 26.10.2023 for the offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 323 and

307 of IPC, in Crime No.356 of 2023 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2.It is stated that there was a previous enmity between the group of the accused person and one of the friend of the defacto complainant. The entire issue was with respect to a lady.

3.It is stated that the accused had assaulted the defacto complainant and others and caused injuries.

4.For good measure, the accused had also given a complaint against the defacto complainant which has been registered as Crime No.357 of 2023 for the offence under Sections 147, 148, 294(b), 323, 324 and 307 of IPC.

5.Taking into consideration all these facts and the period of incarceration undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

6.Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on condition to execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Komarapalayam, and on further

conditions that:

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m until further orders.

[c] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
