## **ORDER**

The petitioner seeks bail in Crime No.184 of 2023, registered by the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 341, 386, 506(1) of IPC. The petitioner had been taken into custody on 31.08.2023.

2.It is stated that on 31.08.2023, the petitioner had demanded money from the defacto complainant, who is running a shop.

3.Counter affidavit had been filed by the respondent wherein it had been stated that there are as many as 24 cases against the petitioner herein. However, four of the cases are pending trial and in two cases, the petitioner had been acquitted and five cases are under investigation and in the other cases though charge sheet filed they have not been taken on record.

4.Taking into consideration all these facts, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner subject to the following conditions:

5.Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on condition to execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two fresh sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the V

Metropolitan Magistrate, Egmore, Chennai, and on further conditions that:

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

**[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police everyday morning at 10.30 a.m., and evening at 5.30 p.m., until further orders.**

[c] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
