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ORDER

The petitioner/accused, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 10.10.2023 in Crime No.236 of 2023 for the offence punishable under Sections 379 IPC on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. It is stated in the petition that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has been falsely implicated in this case. The petitioner had been remanded to custody on 10.10.2023. It is further stated that the petitioner is ready to abide by any stringent condition imposed by this Court. Hence, grant of bail to the petitioner is sought.

3. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) stated that the accused had robbed the mobile phone of the defacto complainant. There are two previous cases as against the petitioner.

4. Taking into consideration the period of incarceration and the fact that the mobile phone had been recovered, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner subject to the following conditions.



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5. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on condition to execute a bond for a sum of **Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only)** with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the **learned Vth Metropolitan Magistrate, Egmore Court**, and on further conditions that:

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police everyday at 10.00 a.m., until further orders.

[c] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial



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Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
