2.The petitioners are accused in Crime No.223 of 2023, registered under Sections 294(b), 323 and 506(i) IPC, which are all bailable offences. In view of the same, application seeking anticipatory bail would not lie. The petitioners are directed to appear before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Omalur, who may pass appropriate orders since the offences are bailable.

3.Accordingly, this criminal original petition stands dismissed.
