2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondents.

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has lodged a complaint before the second respondent for missing of his original sale deed vide document bearing No.4617 of 1982 dated 27.09.1982 in respect of the property which was situated at Trichy District, K.Sathanur Sub Registration District, Sethurapatti Village Ayyan Poonja in Survey No.85/16. He would further submit that the petitioner has also made paper publication with regard to the missing of original document.
