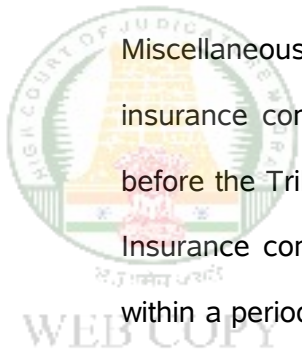
AWARD
