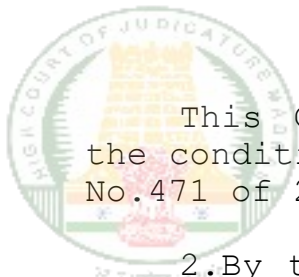

This Criminal Miscellaneous Petition has been filed ax the condition imposed on the petitioner on 17.08.2022 in Crl.A.(MD). No.471 of 2022.

2.By the above said order, this Court directed the petitioners to stay at Villupuram and report before the Inspector of Police, Villupuram Town Police Station, at 10.30 a.m. for a period of 30 days and thereafter, appear before the trial Court on all working days at 10.30 a.m. until further orders.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) submitted that the investigation has been completed and final report has been filed before the III Additional District and Sessions Judge, Special Court for PCR Cases, Madurai, and the same was taken cognizance in Spl.S.C.No.32 of 2022.

4.In view of the submission made by the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) the condition imposed on the petitioner by this Court on 17.08.2022 is relaxed and the petitioner shall appear before the concerned Special Court on every hearing without fail.
