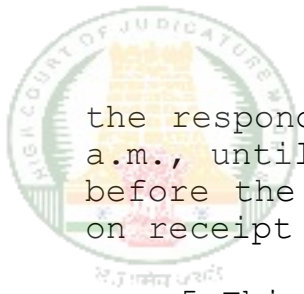
This Petition has been filed to relax the condition imposed in Crl.O.P(MD).No.19371 of 2022, dated 02.11.2022.
