PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents herein to grant permission and protection to conduct the Aadalum Paadalum dance programme on 26.01.2023, 27.01.2023 and 29.01.2023 from 08.00 pm to 12.00 pm in pursuant to the festival of Arulmigu Sri Muthalamman Temple in Pillaiyarkovil Street, Mamsapuram, Srivilliputhur Taluk, Virudhunagar District, by considering the petitioner's representation dated 20.12.2022.

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ORDER

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The writ petitioner filed this Writ Petition seeking for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents herein to grant permission and protection to conduct the Aadalum Paadalum dance programme on 26.01.2023, 27.01.2023 and 29.01.2023 from 08.00 pm to 12.00 pm in pursuant to the festival of Arulmigu Sri Muthalamman Temple in Pillaiyarkovil Street, Mamsapuram, Srivilliputhur Taluk, Virudhunagar District, by considering the petitioner's representation dated 20.12.2022.

2. Mr.E.Antony Sahaya Prabahar, learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice for the respondents. By consent, this writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the writ petitioner submitted that festival for the temple, by name, “Arulmigu Sri Muthalamman Temple in Pillaiyarkovil Street, Mamsapuram, Srivilliputhur Taluk, Virudhunagar District, is going to be held in the Tamil month of Thai. Subsequent to the same, in order to conduct a cultural programme on 26.01.2023, 27.01.2023 and 29.01.2023 they sought permission of the police by giving a representation dated 20.12.2022. But, the first



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respondent has not considered the said representation. Since no order was passed, the writ petitioner has come before this Court for the above said relief.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents would submit that the second respondent has received the representation of the writ petitioner and the same is pending for consideration. He would further submit that they may be permitted to conduct the programme in an alternate place on 26.01.2023, 27.01.2023 and 29.01.2023 from 07.00 p.m. to 10.00 p.m.

5. At this juncture, the learned counsel appearing for the writ petitioner would submit that they are ready to conduct the programme as stated by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor.

6. I have considered the submission of the learned counsel appearing for the writ petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents.

7. It is brought to the notice of this Court that the Director General



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of Police, Tamil Nadu, Chennai had issued a circular memorandum in Rc.007301/Genl.I (1)/2019, dated 09.04.2019, along with instructions to the Inspectors of Police throughout Tamil Nadu for consideration of applications seeking permission for conducting cultural programme. Therefore, in view of the detailed circular and guidelines issued by the Director General of Police, the writ petitioner is directed to give a fresh representation indicating new place and also incorporating the date and time of the cultural programme before the second respondent police and on such representation, the second respondent police is hereby directed to consider the same and pass suitable orders based on the above said circular.

8. With the above direction, this writ petition stands disposed of.
