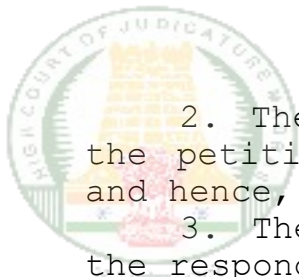
Prayer in CRL MP(MD). 14801/ 2022 :

Considering the said submissions and nature of offence, the condition imposed by this Court in Crl.MP(MD)No.14801 of 2022 in Crl.O.P(MD).No.1383 of 2022, is modified to the effect that the petitioner no.1 shall report before the respondent police once in a month i.e., on first Saturday of every month at 10.30 a.m., until further orders and the petitioner nos.2&3 shall report before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation, on receipt of summons.
