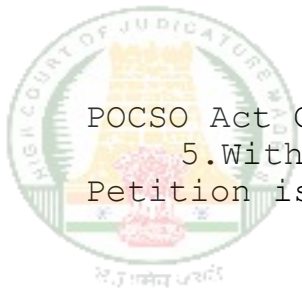

This Petition has been filed to relax the condition imposed in Crl.O.P(MD).No.20291 of 2022, dated 17.11.2022.

2.The learned Counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has been complying with the conditions regularly and hence, he seeks for relaxation of the condition.

3.The learned Government Advocate (crl.side) appearing for the respondent would submit that the investigation has been completed and charge sheet has been filed and the case has been taken on the file of the learned Special Judge, POCSO Act Cases, Tirunelveli.

4.Considering the said submission, the condition imposed by this Court in Crl.O.P(MD).No.20291 of 2022, dated 17.11.2022 is modified to the effect that the petitioner shall appear before the learned Special Judge, POCSO Act Cases, Tirunelveli, on 31.01.2023 and thereafter, on the dates fixed by the learned Special Judge,
