### **ORDER**

2.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the State would submit that the second respondent, after considering the petitioner's representation, has passed an order dated 03.01.2023, rejecting the permission sought for.

3. When the matter is taken up for hearing today, the learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that they are ready to conduct



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meeting in a closed hall or private property such as marriage hall and they are also ready to restrict the people and to produce the list of the participants and also ready to abide by any conditions to be imposed by the first respondent.

4. Considering the above, the petitioner is directed to give a fresh representation to the first respondent and on receipt of the same, the first respondent is directed to consider the representation of the petitioner and pass orders and in case of giving permission, by imposing necessary conditions.

5. With the above directions, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
