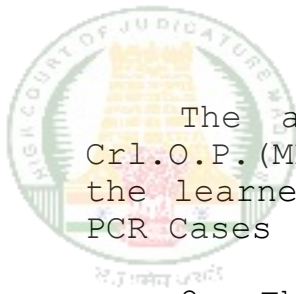
Prayer in CRL MP(MD). No.1124 of 2023:-

Criminal Miscellaneous Petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C, to extend the time for his surrender by another 15 days in Crl.OP(MD)No.19300 of 2022 dated 14.11.2022.

Prayer in Crl.O.P.(MD)No.19300 of 2022:-

Criminal Original Petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C, praying to direct the District and Sessions Court for the Exclusive Trial of PCR Cases (PCR Court), Madurai, to consider the Petitioner's bail application on the same day of his surrender in Crime No.341 of 2022.

2. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner could not surrender before the concerned Court within the stipulated time as prescribed by this Court.

3. Considering the submission made by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, the petitioner is granted 10 days extra time from the date of receipt of a copy of this order to surrender before the learned District and Sessions Judge for the Exclusive Trial of PCR Cases (PCR Court), Madurai. On such surrender, the learned Sessions Judge is directed to consider the same as per law.
